Man begins speaking in Native Language [Inupiaq]. He then says "I am Reverend Charles G. Guest from Kotzebue." The language continues. Another man speaks the same language. Chapter 5-30, 32 of the Bible are read. The two men continue speaking. Some English is spoken occasionally. A woman begins speaking in Native language. Four minutes into the recording there is singing. Marie Nicklaus' name is spoken and she begins to speak at 5:56. She says John 3:16 then continues speaking in the language. Christmas song is spoken among the Native Language. "Silent Night" is then sung in the language at 7:50. After the song Teddy Brinks begins speaking. Nicklaus name is spoken again and a man speaks. At 15:00, another song is sung. At 17:10 another song is sang, led by the reverend. Anna Andrews name is spoken. Anna begins speaking. A woman begins speaking at 22.25. At 23:46 the beginning of the song is sung in English then subsequently the Native language. More singing at 26:00. October 24th is spoken then more singing. Chapter 3, 1-9 is then spoken to the crowd. Chapter 4:1-6 is then spoken. At 36:56 another song is sang. Alexie Pavelovov then speaks. Drew Niklaus then speaks and reads John 16: 22 and 24. At 42:40 the song is sung in English. More singing at 44:50. A woman begins speaking at 46:40. 48:50 the hymn is in English and then Native.
