

MARSHALL Lind, Chancellor, UAF:

This is an exit interview with Chancellor Marshall Lind. A second interview is planned for 5/6/04. In this interview he describes his early childhood experiences, the influence of his mother and his father in law. He describes teaching in Kwajalein, Emmonak, and Goodnews Bay. He traces developments of the <sup>State</sup> Dept of Education as it took over from the Bureau of Indian Affairs, the development of the rural School Districts and the Mally Hootch decision. All of this took place while he was Commissioner of Education.

He describes development of University of Alaska Southeast under his Chancellorship and the decision to come to UAF. He begins the discussion of budgetary matters at UAF.
